COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT INITIATIVES

JUNIOR GIRLS DEVELOPMENT SESSION

The session will be held on the Tuesday afternoon of the event, and will see junior girls attend clinics and mentor sessions suited to their abilities.

- Elite Session a mentor session for existing elite female golfers in the surrounding community, hosted by some of Australia's best professional females sharing their experience on the world professional tour. The session is aimed at the future stars of the game, in preparation for their professional careers.
- **Performance Clinic** a clinic aimed at those girl golfers who currently play the game, for enjoyment rather than pursuing a career in the sport. The expert tuition from Female PGA Teaching Professionals and demonstrations from touring professionals will be sure to entertain and inspire.
- **Beginner Clinic** for those looking to have a go, this clinic will focus on the fundamentals of the game, providing the introduction to inspire new golfers to take up the game.

ONCOURSE VILLAGE AND ACTIVATIONS

A hub of activity will be available on course with our Championship Village and Partner activations including food and beverage outlets to compliment the Gold Coast Festival of Golf activations at the Village.

INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

The Saturday of tournament week will see International Women's Day become a focus piece of the tournament. We will provide additional details as planning continues.






COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT VOLUNTEERING

Volunteers are the backbone of Australian golf, from those who support our clubs and facilities, serve on boards and committees, all the way to those at our amateur events and major professional tournaments.

Various roles are available dependent on the scale of the event, including but not limited to:

- Walker Scorers
- Carry Board Holders
- Hole Marshals
- Ball Spotters
- Practice Range
- Scoring
- Drink Carriers
- Volunteer HQ
- Player Transport
- TV Production & Media

These roles require different attributes (i.e. some, but not all, require golf knowledge, others require long periods of standing, some require heavy lifting). Ideally individuals will have a strong customer service focus, a friendly demeanor, and a hold a current Working with Children Check (or equivalent).





VOLUNTEERING

Australian Golf uses Rosterfy for its event volunteers. Rosterfy is a world-renowned volunteer management system designed to streamline volunteer recruitment, scheduling, management and communication. It offers a range of features aimed at making volunteer coordination and the volunteer experience more efficient and effective.

Once volunteers have registered and created a Rosterfy account, they are able to view and express interest for volunteering opportunities in golf.

Via Rosterfy volunteers can:

- View and express interest for golf volunteering opportunities.
- Access volunteer induction and training modules.
- Select, confirm or decline shifts.
- View rosters.
- Keep up to date with the Australian Golf volunteer
- program.
- View and update their profile.

Applications for volunteering opportunities are directly managed via Rosterfy. This is a 2-step process:



CROWD MANAGEMENT


car Parking will be free and located at Cypress Point for with Shuttle Buses running to the main Sanctuary Cove bus stop.

The event will have various secruity points, involving soft and hard secruity.




VENUE OVERVIEW





- **Kids' Zone** with interactive golf activities such as putt putt and chipping challenges.

















ACCESS & OPERATIONS

The Gold Coast Festival of Golf is a free event for all to enjoy and will take place in The Marine Village alongside the Australian WPGA Championship from Thursday 6 to Sunday 9 March 2025.

- A 20x40m exhibition pavilion will be erected in the main Village car park, adjacent to Jabiru House, with the build commencing from Wednesday 26 March.
- Car parking will be free and unrestricted at the main Village car parks throughout the event, with overflow parking at Cypress Point. Volunteers will assist to direct cars to overflow car park as needed.
- The Village streets from the IGA roundabout will be blocked to vehicle traffic during the exhibitor bump in (2-3 days), event days and exhibitor bump out (1 day).
- Shuttle buses will run from Cypress Point and any other overflow car parks (if required) to the main Sanctuary Cove bus stop.
- The Village will have roving 24/7 security during event days.
- The event is expected to attract 60+ golf and lifestyle exhibits, as well as free golf activations, entertainment and kids' zones. In addition to this, an 'eat & drink' zone will feature 20+ stalls for operators of craft breweries, wineries, distilleries and food trucks.

QUESTIONS

What days and hours will each course be closed for practice and the tournament?

A: The Palms Course will be closed from 12.01pm on Sunday of Championship week until 11.59pm on the last day of the Championship Week. For 2025 those dates will be Sunday 2nd March - Sunday 9th March inclusive.

As a golf club member what do you anticipate the cost of the course updates to be for the tournament?

A: As part of the event Sanctuary Cove Golf and Country Club will receive a fee from Mulpha to support course preparations.

What are the options for player billeting?

A: Billeting involves local residents providing a players with a room for the tournament week. Additional provisions of meals, transportation and internet access can be provided at the discretion of the host resident. Billeting allows players to enjoy the comforts of home whilst preparing for tournament week and helps the players financially. If you are interested in becoming a Host Billet please complete the below Expression of Interest Form.

On what platforms will the tournament be broadcast?

A: The WPGA Championship will comprise of a 2-Day Broadcast (Saturday and Sunday) on Free to Air, Fox and Kayo platforms. There will be an announcement shortly on the overall broadcast.





QUESTIONS

Car parking, what are the options for visitors, considering current car park being taken up by Pavilion?

A: Whilst the pavilion will reduce parking at the village, the tournament and Gold Coast Festival of Golf will utilise the overflow parking at Cypress Point. Mulpha and the PGA are also exploring additional park and ride options as required.

How will attendees get from shuttle bus/Village to the course for tournament?

A: Shuttle buses will run from Cypress Point to the Village Bus Stop. Entry to the Gold Coast Festival of Golf will be to the left of the Village bus stop and Tournament Entry will be to the right of the village bus stop.

What is the plan around kangaroo and wildlife management?

A: The PGA, Mulpha and Sanctuary Cove Golf and Country Club are currently working with Biodiversity Australia to develop a comprehensive wildlife management plan to ensure the safety of players, spectators, residents and animals. Additional signage to alert patrons of wildlife will be a ley piece of this plan, as well as the guidance provided by Biodiversity Australia.

What security will be in place for homes behind the gates? Also to prevent visitors accessing lawns and yards?


A: Tournament security will involve a combination of hard security, soft security, and volunteers, along with strategic roping plans to ensure proper protection for homes behind the gates. Hard security will include professional personnel stationed at key access points to control entry and ensure safety. Soft security, such as roving security teams, will be in place to monitor the event and handle any issues as they arise. Volunteers will also assist in guiding attendees and supporting security measures. Roping plans will help define boundaries and restrict visitors from accessing private lawns and yards. This layered approach will help maintain a secure environment throughout the tournament.

VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

Working with Children Check (Blue Card) Information:

As part of Australian Golf's commitment to providing safe events, all volunteers are required to obtain a valid Working With Children Check (Blue Card) to participate in our voluinteer program.

You are able to express your interest to Volunteer without obtaining a Blue Card. If you do not have a Blue Card, you will be prompted on registration to apply. Once you have applied the PGA will be requited to link you to our event, once linked Blue Card Services will then process your application.

Please find below information to assist you in finalising the required details

Queensland Volunteers – will need to be linked to the PGA of Australia via one of two methods

- Volunteers with existing and valid Blue Card:
 - Please complete the form here confirming your date of birth and your current Blue Card Exemption Number
- Volunteers who are applying for a new Blue Card or renewing their expired Blue Card
 - Register via the Blue Card Portal linked here
 - o Once you have registered you will receive an email with your account number
 - Complete the form here with your date of birth and your account number
- The PGA will link you to our event, and Blue Card Services will then process your application.
